(Carson City, NV)- Carson City Health and Human Services (CCHHS) is reporting 4 additional deaths due to COVID-19 in the Quad-County Region. The individuals were:

- A female Lyon County resident in her 80’s
- A female Carson City resident in her 80’s
- A female Carson City resident in her 80’s
- A female Carson City resident in her 90’s

CCHHS is also reporting 15 new cases and 10 additional recoveries of COVID-19 in the Quad-County Region. This brings the total number of cases to 11,086, with 8,673 recoveries and 207 deaths; 2,206 cases remain active.
